Timelines ~ Getting you to October 18th

With the Food & Drug Administration (FDA) approving <u>full</u> <u>authorization of the Pfizer COVID-19 Vaccine</u> timelines for educator & support staff vaccination becomes all more important. Counting back from the October 18th timeline the below is provided to assist in planning when a first dose should be received depending on CDC recommendations.

- Moderna: (28 days between shots): Sept 6th
- <u>Pfizer</u>: (21 days between shots): Sept 13th
- J&J: (single dose): Oct 4th



People are considered fully vaccinated 2 weeks after their second dose of Pfizer or Moderna vaccines, or 2 weeks after the single-dose J&J vaccine. The above timeline is for information purposes only and shouldn't be considered a substitute for information provided by your primary care doctor.
